An effective leader evaluates each participant's capabilities and needs.

A flexible leader adjusts delivery of program material to participant's level and fit. A terrific leader recognizes the teachable moments – how to make it stick and be fun!

- 4 Lead by example actions speak louder than words.
- Respect your participants their individuality, their different levels of skill, their confidence, and their passion for biking.
- Have fun, and make it fun use your sense of humour to keep it playful.
- Have time for everyone make the participants feel important and proud.
- The Celebrate even the smallest of accomplishments yours and your riders'!
- → Don't give up!

Master Trainer Good Habits

- Always wear your helmet lead by example!
- Carry a pack with the following items: tool kit, basic first aid kit, emergency contact information, radio or cellphone.
- Keep it simple teach one skill at a time, and link your lessons to previously taught skills. Use circuit training to put it all together.
- Mon trail rides, use a 'sweep' designate one rider to bring up the rear.
- Keep together as a group.
